<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Regular Sort</b></p> <p>Cut and sort your words according to the rules you learned at school. Store the words in an envelope.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Word Hunt</b></p> <p>Glue your sort in your spiral. Find words from books and magazines that fit your sort and add them to your spiral.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Dictionary Dig</b></p> <p>Find each word in the dictionary. Write your word, page number, and the 2 guide words next to your word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Be an Inventor</b></p> <p>Invent a new product and write an advertisement for it with at least 10 words.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Alphabetical Order</b></p> <p>Cut and sort your words in alphabetical order within the columns. Then put all the words in ABC order! Store the words in an envelope.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Speed Sort</b></p> <p>Sort your words as quickly as you can by reading the word and placing it in the correct column. Glue the words after the 3rd speed sort.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Synonyms &amp; Antonyms</b></p> <p>Write each word, then list a synonym and antonym for each one.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Scrabble Spelling</b></p> <p>Spell your words with Scrabble tiles then add up the value of each word.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Colorful Sort</b></p> <p>Cut and sort your words according to the rules. Trace the vowels and consonants in different colors. Store the words in an envelope.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Open Sort</b></p> <p>Sort your words a different way. See if someone can guess your categories, then glue your words the regular way.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Be a Writer</b></p> <p>Use at least 10 words to write a letter to a friend or a fiction story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Blind Writing Sort</b></p> <p>Have a parent say your words aloud while you write the words in the correct column. Check for accuracy as you read each column.</p>
